It is an easy way to continue loving animals long after you are gone. Your monetary donations will be utilized by our kennel for the daily care of our dogs—feeding them, taking care of their injuries, vaccinating them against disease, providing medicines, and give them a warm, safe, and loving home until they find permanent homes. By leaving a monetary donation to Canine Rescue, you will have helped those who have no voice—those wonderful dogs who are unable to ask for help themselves.

There are several ways that you can contribute to our dogs' welfare via your estate. Please consult with your estate planner and/or attorney or call our Rescue at (717)232-1644. In addition to being in your will, you may name Canine Rescue in your life insurance policy, 401K plan, and/or pension/retirement plan. You will need our federal ID number for your policy documents, to prevent any confusion with other animal welfare groups (not that we do not want you to help them, too!). We cannot accept properties (land) left directly to our shelter. Instead, you may instruct your estate to sell your property and convey the proceeds to Canine Rescue.

Canine Rescue of Central PA, Inc., is a 501c(3) nonprofit organization that receives no local, state, or federal money—we operate solely on donations. We are an all-volunteer group dedicated to providing assistance to any dog in a helpless situation. Our organization was formed in 2002, and we have made tremendous progress in establishing another valuable resource for our furry friends. It is Canine Rescue of Central PA's mission to get involved in as many situations as possible to provide sanctuary, shelter, and homes to as many dogs as we can. We also are very focused on creating strategic partnerships with other rescues and similar organizations in an attempt to share resources as well as expand public awareness of the overwhelming problem of homeless animals. As of January 1, 2014, we had placed over 640 dogs in new, loving homes!
